The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.117 dated 22.06.2020 registered under Sections 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 325, 326, 307 and 308 IPC added later on) at Police Station Shri Hargobindpur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version and even a compromise has been effected between the parties. The compromise has been

signed by the injured as well. The case is still at the stage of investigation. Notice of motion was issued on 03.12.2020 and arrested of the petitioner was stayed.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2, 3 and 4 admits the factum of compromise.

Looking to the aforesaid circumstances, I am of the view that the petitioner has made out a case for the grant of anticipatory bail. The petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 17.03.2021 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.
