Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned result dated 19.10.2021 (Annexure P-7), claiming he is more meritorious than the last selected candidate in BC-A Category for the post of Sub-Inspector (Male). Grievance also is that objections filed by him have not been decided.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for mitigation of his grievance, petitioner submitted a representation dated 20.10.2021 (Annexure P-8), but to no avail. Hence, the instant petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel joins proceedings and that competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending representation of the petitioner, in due course.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, by the competent authority on the pending representation dated 20.10.2021 (Annexure P-8).

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondent as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 20.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from today. Till the decision is rendered, one post of Sub-Inspector in the BC-A category shall be kept vacant and in case the petitioner is found meritorious, the benefit thereof be accorded to him.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
