Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to
place on record the judgment dated 23.12.2020 as Annexure A-1.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and
the document-Annexure A-1 is taken on record, subject to all just
exceptions.

CRMs-M-40472 & 42684-2020

This order shall dispose of two petitions i.e. ***CRM-M-40472-2020*** titled as ***Sandeep Ranga Versus State of Haryana*** and ***CRM-M-42684-2020*** titled as ***Dinesh Saini Versus State of Haryana***.

Prayer in both these petitions filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner(s) in case FIR No.537 dated 03.08.2020 registered under Sections 381, 408, 420, 34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Hisar.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the role attributed to the petitioner(s) is similar to that of the co-accused Vinay Kumar, who has been admitted on bail by this Court vide order dated 23.12.2020 passed in ***CRM-M-42203-2020*** titled as ***Vinay Kumar Versus State of Haryana***. Petitioners are in custody since 05.10.2020.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioners are in custody since 05.10.2020. Considering the fact the co-accused Vinay Kumar has already been admitted on bail by this Court and the offences are triable by Magistrate, coupled with the fact that no other case has been pointed out against the petitioners, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioners on bail.

Accordingly, the present petitions are allowed and the petitioners are admitted on regular bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
