Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.49 dated 19.05.2020 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

On 23.11.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact the complainant gave Rs.1,50,000/- to three persons including the petitioner. Share of the petitioner was Rs.50,000/-. Out of the aforesaid amount of Rs.50,000/-, petitioner has already returned an amount of Rs.27,500/-. Though the petitioner had returned an amount of Rs.90,000/- on account of

settlement, but no receipt was issued by the complainant party. Even the petitioner is ready to return Rs.22,500/- i.e. Remaining amount of his share of Rs.50,000/-.

Notice of motion for 05.02.2021.

Till the next date of hearing, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

Thereafter, the petitioner was allowed to join the investigation subject to the condition as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagar Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation in the case.

In view of the aforesaid position, the order dated 05.02.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
