The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 114 dated 04.11.2020 under Sections 341, 354-B, 323, 506 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

By an order dated 08.02.2021, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.
