Petitioner – Pankaj, who claims to be 10+2 pass with 100% hearing impairment disability, pursuant to admission notice dated 10.9.2020, Annexure P-4, issued by respondent no. 1, applied for Diploma Level Courses in Special Education and Disability Rehabilitation. His grievance in the present petition is that despite his being higher in merit with 63.4% marks in 12th Class, candidates lower in merit in terms of marks obtained by them in 12th Class have been selected. Hence, the present writ petition *inter alia* with the prayer to set aside the merit list dated 5.11.2020, Annexure P-6.

Notice of motion was issued.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has been admitted in the course applied for.

Dismissed as infructuous.
