The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release interest on delayed payment of Gratuity to the petitioners as well as to decide the legal notice dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P3), as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
