The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to assess, compute and pay the final pension of the petitioner along with all other pensionary benefits, gratuity etc the delay in payment of which is illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory, unreasonable and violative of the provisions of Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972, the Central Civil Services (Commutation of Pension) Rules, 1981 as well as Article 21 of the Constitution of India in the interest of justice, equity and fair play.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 07.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
