The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.271 dated 04.07.2020, under Section 379-A IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line, Jind, District Jind, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had snatched the bag of the complainant containing a sum of Rs.85,000/-. He further submits that the petitioner is about 19 year of age and is not involved in any other criminal case. He is in custody for over 7 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Krishan, contends that challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed. He further contends that recovery of Rs.2,000/- was effected from the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is 19 year of age, he is in custody for over 7 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
