This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the concerned authorities to grant to the petitioner emergency parole for a period of six weeks so as to enable him to take care of his wife keeping in view her health conditions.

As per averments made in the petition, petitioner is presently confined in District Jail, Rohtak and is undergoing sentence pursuant to having been convicted in a trial emanating from FIR No.202 dated 16.06.2012 registered under Sections 302, 364, 34 and 201 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

It is the categoric contention raised by counsel that two

separate applications dated 14.10.2021 and 21.10.2021 have been submitted to the Superintendent, District Jail, Rohtak, Haryana/respondent No.3 but till date no decision thereupon has been taken.

Notice in the petition.

Mr. Aman Bahri, learned Addl. A.G. Haryana, joined proceedings and accepts notice.

Learned State counsel very fairly submits that in case the petitioner has applied for parole, the application would be considered strictly as per law and under the provisions of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 and a final decision would be taken within a period of one week from today.

In the light of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the State, no further directions are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of.
