SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

FIR No.72 of 24.05.2021, constitutes therein offences under Sections 379-B, 473, 411 of IPC, and, is lodged at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot, therein the incriminating offence is attributed to be committed by the bail applicant.

2. Learned counsel for the State submits, that all the relevant recoveries have been effected, at the instance of the accused, by the investigating officer. Learned State counsel also submits, that after completion of investigations in the FIR supra, the investigating officer has filed report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., before the learned Magistrate concerned, and, thereafter, the latter has proceeded to draw charges against the accused.

3. Consequently, it is not deemed fit and appropriate to prolong the judicial incarceration of the accused, as he is suffering incarceration, for the last five months. In addition with the co-accused also becoming granted bail by the

learned Court concerned, thereupon on application of principle of parity to the bail applicant, this Court is also inclined to grant indulgence of bail to him.

4. Consequently, the instant petition is allowed, and, the petitioner-bail applicant is ordered to be released from judicial custody. However, the granting of bail, is subject to the bail applicant-petitioner furnishing personal and surety bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- each, before the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned, and, also subject to his not tampering with prosecution evidence, and, his not influencing prosecution witnesses, and, besides also his appearing before the trial Court concerned, as and when directed to make his personal appearance. He shall also surrender his passport before the learned Magistrate concerned.
