On 18.12.2020, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

This writ petition has been filed for issuing directions to regulate the practice and procedure for deposit of the amount by the Insurance Companies on passing of the award of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunals. The petitioner-company relies upon various judgments/orders passed by different High Courts in this regard.

In the meantime, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No.(S) Civil No.(S). 534 of 2020 titled as '**Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Pvt. Ltd. vs. Union of India and others**' decided on 16.03.2021 has passed a detailed judgment giving general directions.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that in view of the aforesaid order passed, no further order is required to be passed in this writ petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
