1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent-Bank to refer the case of the petitioner to the Designated Committee constituted under Clause 3.3 of the Revival & Rehabilitation of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises dated 17.03.2016 issued by Reserve Bank of India (Annexure P-11) and further prayer for issuing a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing notice dated 28.02.2020 (Annexure P-4), 27.05.2020 (Annexure P-6) issued under Section 13 of the Securitization and Reconstructions of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 and reply dated 05.08.2020 (Annexure P-13) and subsequent rejection letter dated 20.10.2020 of the respondent-Bank (Annexure P-16).

2. On 16.02.2021, the following order was passed:

“Reply filed on behalf of the respondent is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent seeks one day time to get instructions whether the matter can be referred to the Designated Committee which has been cited in the writ petition.

Adjourned to 19.02.2021.”

3. Today, Mr.Gaurav Goel, counsel for the respondent-Bank submits that the case of the petitioner has been referred to the Designated Committee. He further states that till the period the matter is not decided by the Committee, no action shall be taken against the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands dismissed as infructuous.
