AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 2, dated 5.1.2021 under Sections 376, 354, 323, 511 of IPC and Sections 4, 8 and 18 of the POCSO Act, 2012 (2019), registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time realizing that reliance on a compromise deed annexed with the petition is not finding favour with the Bench, in order to avoid any adverse order, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within ten days from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within ten days from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
