ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

The petitioner is a convict and is currently lodged in Central Jail
Ambala.

Vide this petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution, she
prays for parole under Sections 3 and 4 of the Haryana Good Conduct
Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 (for short 'the Act'), as marriage
of her daughter (Shiwani) is slated to take place on 21.11.2021.

Mr. Deepak Balyan, learned Addl.A.G. Haryana, who upon
being served with an advance copy of the petition, is present in Court,
submits that petition at hands is wholly misconceived as the petitioner ought
to have moved the authorities concerned, in terms of Section 3 of the Act, in
the first instance.

Faced with this and having argued the matter at some length,

learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the authorities under the Act. However, he submits, for, the matter is time sensitive he would move the necessary application in terms of the provisions of the Act within two days from today, and therefore, the authorities be directed that in the event any such application is moved the same be dealt with, at the earliest.

In response, Mr. Deepak Balyan, as always, fairly submits that if any such application is made by the petitioner it shall be considered on priority and necessary orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed thereupon, within three days of its receipt by the competent authority.

In the wake of the above, the petition is accordingly disposed of in terms of the statement of learned counsel for the parties.
