[1] Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant contends that CRM-M No.26276 of 2021 was dismissed as withdrawn on 14.10.2021 on the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner that he would file a fresh petition at the appropriate stage after examination of the complainant in accordance with law, if the circumstances of the case so warranted, but the complainant has not been examined on account of non-appearance of complainant.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the instant petition and would file a fresh petition, if the circumstances of the case so warrant in terms of order dated 14.10.2021 in CRM-M No.26276 of 2021 after examination of the complainant provided the complainant participates in the proceedings before the learned trial court.

[3] Learned counsel for the complainant undertakes that the complainant would be present before the learned trial Court on the next date of hearing.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
