The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0140 dated 02.10.2020, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner and other accused had taken money from the complainant for sending him abroad. He, however, contends that the petitioner has been implicated just because she is the sister of co-accused, namely, Harpreet Singh. She is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court by the order dated 04.12.2020 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Gurcharan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 04.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
