This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.251 dated 29.06.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 188, 323, 324, 326 and 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Ferozepur-Jhirka, District Nuh. The petitioner apprehend his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 04.12.2020, the following order was passed:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in respect of occurrence dated 07.06.2020, FIR came to be registered on 29.06.2020. The alleged injury on the person of Shoyab was on non vital part being a cut and fracture of metacarpal bone allegedly attributed to the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that it is case of version and cross version.

*Notice of motion for 12.02.2021.
Till the next date of hearing, arrest of the petitioner
shall remain stayed.”*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by HC Surender Kumar has stated that the petitioner was called on number of occasions to associate himself with the investigation, however, he has failed to do so.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no such direction to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to justify the conduct of the petitioner as he failed to join the investigation for a long time after getting the concession on 04.12.2020.

Resultantly, considering the conduct of the petitioner, no case is made out for grant of extra ordinary concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.
