Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 27.11.2020 (P-5), passed by respondent No.2, vide which, petitioner was dismissed from his service. Further prayer is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to reinstate the petitioner to his original post along with all consequential benefits. Also prayed that impugned order dated 27.11.2020 (P-5) may kindly be stayed during the pendency of the present writ petition.

Concededly, there is a remedy of statutory appeal available to the petitioner under Rule 19 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970.

In view of the above, a prayer has been made on behalf of the petitioner seeking permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file the statutory appeal.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

It is made clear that in case the statutory appeal is preferred within two weeks from today, the point of limitation may not be considered as hindrance to the petitioner and in view of the controversy involved, the same be decided expeditiously according to law, if there is no legal impediment.
