The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh Police Station Sirhali District Tarn Taran submits that the petitioner has been declared as *proclaimed offender* vide order dated 28.10.2021 by the Court of Mr. Harpreet Singh, JMJC, Tarn Taran. The same could not be displaced by the counsel for the petitioner Mr. L.S. Sidhu. Even the contentions of the counsel for the petitioner that compromise has been effected has been stoutly opposed by Mr. Vikas Gupta, learned counsel for the complainant.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement withdrawing the present petition, however, reserving the rights of the petitioner to first challenge the order declaring the petitioner as *proclaimed offender* and, thereafter, approach this Court afresh on same very grounds.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
