Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is a senior citizen, and to take action against the respondents No.3 to 6, who are harassing the petitioner by calling him and his brother to the Police Station to compromise the matter with respondent No.6.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had a dispute with respondent No.6, which has been enquired into, and after finding no substance in the complaints submitted by respondent No.6, they have been consigned to the record. Counsel asserts that respondent No.6 is repeatedly submitting representations qua the same dispute and official

respondents No.3 to 5 are harassing him at the behest of respondent No.6. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, petitioner has submitted representation dated 05.07.2021 (Annexure P-8) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar – respondent No.2, which has not been attended to and the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to examine the same.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar – respondent No.2, to examine the representation dated 05.07.2021 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law, in case any substance is found in the same.

A copy of this order as well as representation dated 05.07.2021 (Annexure P-8) be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
