Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer in the present petition under Section 407 of Cr.P.C. is for transfer of Criminal Appeal No. 109/2019 titled as 'Ramesh Kumar Vs. Suman Devi' pending in the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Rewari, to the Court of competent jurisdiction in any District other than Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide judgment and order dated 29.04.2019 passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari, the respondent was found guilty for the offence under Section 420 IPC and sentenced to undergo the sentence for 5 years and to pay a fine of Rs. 1000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the respondent is a Government employee and is also having good relations with the Officers and practicing Advocates in District Rewari. The respondent,

being an influential person, has been trying to influence the Presiding Officer to pass an order in his favour. It is, thus, contended that the petitioner apprehends that the respondent may get the desired relief by exerting his said influence upon the Presiding Officer.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The apprehension of the petitioner is misplaced. As noticed above, the trial Court has found the respondent guilty for the offence under Section 420 IPC and sentenced him accordingly. Had there been any influential approach on his part as alleged by the petitioner, he might have not ended into being found guilty and sentenced.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant any relief as prayed for.

Dismissed.
