The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

In compliance of order dated 8.2.2021, affidavit of Shri Dhruvan H. Nimbale, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran has been filed wherein it has been stated that an inquiry was marked to DSP (Investigation) Tarn Taran. The DSP (Investigation) Tarn Taran has submitted a report dated 19.3.2021 wherein it has been stated that call details of all police officials who were part of raiding party on 16.7.2020 were procured from Technical Support Unit and examined. As per report of Technical Support Unit, the tower locations of police party on 16.7.2020 had not been found to be the house of Kuldeep Singh alias Lovely as alleged by petitioner.

In view thereof, this contempt petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

Needless to add that it will be open to petitioner to avail of any other appropriate remedy, if aggrieved.
