The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 62 dated 29.08.2021, under Sections 379, 411 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Patara, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the co-accused were apprehended while stealing wire from the motor of the complainant while the petitioner is alleged to have run away. The petitioner does not have criminal antecedents. The stolen wire has been recovered from the co-accused.

This Court, by the order dated 28.10.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 28.10.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
