This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C., in case FIR No.206 dated 17.04.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 326, 452, 506 & 302 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for almost 8 months, since 31.08.2020.

[3]. Attention of the Court has been drawn to the fact that co-accused Irshad, Islam, Mosim, Shokat Ali and others have already been granted bail by this Court as also by the Ld. Trial Court itself.

[4]. In the impugned order dated 16.11.2020 (Annexure P-6), the Ld. Sessions Judge, Mewat has also noted in Para No.6 that even the complainant had no objection, if the petitioner is granted bail.

[5]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner by now, as also the fact that several other co-accused have already been

granted bail earlier and also that the trial, on account of on going Covid-19 Pandemic, is likely to take its own substantial time to complete, since so far 2 witness from the prosecution side has been examined, as such further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for and he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
