The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 31 dated 17.04.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion was issued. Vide order dated 08.12.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate on 23.12.2020 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 19.01.2021 of learned JMIC, Malerkotla, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC, Malerkotla and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that she is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 31 dated 17.04.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
