This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Claim in the instant petition was for directing the respondents to grant to the petitioner benefit of maternity leave for the period from 19.8.2020 to 19.02.2021.

Advance copy of the petition has already been served upon State of Haryana. Mr. Sharan Sethi, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has forwarded through email a copy of the order dated 21.12.2020 passed by the Joint Director Colleges, Office of Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula and a copy of which is taken on record as Mark 'A'. Perusal of the order dated 21.12.2020 at Mark 'A' reveals that the petitioner has been granted maternity leave for 180 days i.e. from 19.08.2020 to 14.02.2021.

Needless to mention that the necessary benefits emanating from the order dated 21.12.2020, Mark 'A' be released to the petitioner without any further delay.
