Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

However, the petitioner is directed to surrender, and, appear before the learned trial Magistrate concerned on or before 26.11.2021, and, till his appearance before the learned trial Magistrate, no coercive action be taken against him by the respondent-State. However, only subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court concerned, and with an undertaking, that as and when he is required to make his personal appearance, before the learned trial Court, he shall appear before the learned trial Court concerned.

It is also clarified that on surrender and appearance of the petitioner, before the learned trial Magistrate concerned, the latter, in accordance with law, on an appropriate application being preferred by the petitioner-accused, with respect to recalling of the orders declaring him a proclaimed offender, shall make appropriate orders in accordance with law,
