Limited prayer for which the petitioner has come up before this Court is that condition of furnishing the bank guarantee to the tune of Rs.30,000/- or on deposit of cash of Rs.30,000/-, be waived off.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a very poor person and unable to furnish the bank guarantee or to deposit the cash amount and no purpose would be served in case the vehicle in question is not released.

Given above, the condition of furnishing bank guarantee or cash deposit is hereby over-ruled. There is no necessity to furnish bank guarantee. Only a personal bond/undertaking to pay an amount of Rs.30,000/- would be sufficient.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed.
