The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.114 dated 19.06.2018, under Sections 420/120-B IPC (Offence under Section 3A and 25 of Pre Conception and Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act, 1994 added later on), registered at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had approached the co-accused Jagbir for getting the sex determination of his friend's wife through the co-accused doctor.

This Court, by the order dated 18.12.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
