The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0283 dated 14.11.2020 under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC, 1860 and Section 25/54 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sector-06, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 22.12.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lokesh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.12.2020, is hereby made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
