Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution

of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting

aside the selection process under Advertisement No.1/2021 for the post of

Sub-Inspector (Male) in Haryana Police as respondent No.2 is not disclosing

the result of Physical Screening Test (PST) and not allowing the petitioner to

participate in the further process of selection i.e. Physical Measurement Test

(PMT), scrutiny of documents etc.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from the Secretary,

Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Haryana, has informed that the

petitioner-*Sandeep*, who participated in the Physical Screening Test (PST)

under Roll No.3211025435 did not qualify the same on account of not

covering the distance of 2.5 kms. within the stipulated period of 12 minutes.

Learned State Counsel further states that as per the RIFD bands,

which were affixed on the legs of the participants, the start, split, finish and net time of the petitioner is as under:--

Sandeep	:	3211025435
Start	:	07:51:24:100
Split	:	07:58:10:400
Finish	:	08:03:42:200
Net time	:	12:18:100

[4] A perusal thereof reveals that the net time availed by the petitioner is 12 minutes, 18 seconds and 100 milli seconds i.e. beyond the stipulated period of 12 minutes.

[5] In view of the position noted above, no case is made out for interfering in the selection process on account of the petitioner not having passed the Physical Screening Test (PST) within the stipulated period of 12 minutes.
