This is second petition for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 17 dated 24.3.2018 registered under Sections 22 of NDPS Act 61/1985, at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran

The first petition was dismissed on 04.09.2019, with the following order:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 17 dated 24.3.2018 registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

Alleged recovery from the petitioner is 700 tablets of Alprazolam which falls within the ambit of commercial quantity. Still further petitioner is a previous convict under Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act. Hence, no ground for grant of regular bail is made out. Accordingly, present petition is hereby dismissed. However, trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavour to conclude the trial within one year.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, although, made a sincere attempt, however, failed to draw the attention of the Court to any fresh

or new ground for grant of bail.

Hence, dismissed.
