The petitioner is aggrieved because his representation dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P-13) has not been decided till date. The allegation in the representation is that respondent No.9 has been wrongly allotted a ration depot. The documents submitted with the application were forged.

On being questioned, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the averment in the application that respondent No.9 acquired knowledge of the allotment process through an announcement made in the Gurudwara is false.

Assuming that the above is correct, the same cannot be a ground for cancelling the licence because acquisition of knowledge could be through any other means also. It is not an essential document for issuance a licence.

Realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with him, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
