The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the daily wage as Special Police Officer (SPO) service of the petitioner, rendered before his regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits in terms of Annexures P7 to P10, and further to grant all arrears of pay and consequential benefits along with interest @ 12% p.a. as well as to decide the legal notice dated 27.07.2021 (Annexure P-11).
