ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.276 dated 17.08.2021, under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 06, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that three accused had taken away mobile phone and had caused injuries on the arms of the complainant. The injuries were simple in nature. He also contends that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of a misunderstanding. The complainant has stated that the petitioner was not the person who was involved in the occurrence. He has referred to the affidavit of the complainant at Annexure P-2. The petitioner is not involved in any other case and he is in custody for about 4 months.

Learned State, upon instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, contends that challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined. He is in custody for 3 ½ months.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 3 ½ months, he is not involved in any other case, the COVID-19

pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
