The petitioner herein is Gram Panchayat of village Gulwati. The plaintiff is the defendant in a suit for grant of decree of permanent injunction. It is the stand of the Gram Panchayat that on an application, filed under Section 4 and 7 of the Punjab Public Premises and Land (Eviction & Rent Recovery) Act, 1973, the possession of the property in question was delivered and it has subsequently been leased out.

Through this revision petition, the petitioner assails the correctness of the order passed by the trial court while dismissing its application for dismissal of the suit. The court has noticed that the case is fixed for final arguments.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere in the impugned order is made out.
