The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 386 dated 04.05.2017 under Sections 323 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 10, Gurugram, and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 appeared.

Vide order dated 11.12.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate on 18.12.2020 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 04.01.2021 of learned JMIC, Gurugram, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC, Gurugram and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 386 dated 04.05.2017 under Sections 323 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 10, Gurugram, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
