This is a first petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.132 dated 01.06.2019 under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, Punjab and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 11.07.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case apart from respondent No.2-Yaasin, one Gurvinder Singh is also the victim/complainant and, thus, he is a necessary party and the compromise is also required to be entered into with the said Gurvinder Singh.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise after impleading all the necessary parties and getting the compromise effected between them.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
