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**MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case pertaining to the FIR bearing No.0172 dated 11.11.2019 registered at Police Station Titram, District Kaithal, under Sections 406, 420, 506 read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh of Police Station Titram, District Kaithal, apprises the Court that despite having been afforded five (05) opportunities to join in the investigation as directed by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the order passed on 22.04.2021 while extending the interim relief of anticipatory bail to

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him, the petitioner has not joined in the investigation and moreover, his (petitioner's) custodial interrogation is required to elicit the truth about the *modus operandi* as adopted by him as well as his co-accused in the alleged crime and also for the recovery of the amount as fraudulently obtained by him from the complainant.

Keeping in view the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, this Court is of the considered opinion that the petitioner does not deserve the relief of anticipatory bail. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed accordingly.
