The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.239 dated 06.07.2020 registered under Sections 177, 199, 200 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, District Karnal.

On 06.04.2021, following order was passed by this Court:-

The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

"Notice of motion was issued on 11.12.2020 on the premise that the contents of FIR do not prima facie satisfy the requirement of Section 195 (1) (b) Cr.P.C. The authorization in favour of Pawan Kumar, Reader has not come on record and the offences except

offence under Section 420 IPC are bailable in nature. Even the ingredients of offence under Section 420 IPC would remain debatable.

*In view of above, it would be just and appropriate to direct the petitioner to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on **11.04.2021** at 11.00 A.M. and in the event of her arrest, she shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on her furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

List on 06.07.2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the order dated 06.04.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jatinder Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.04.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
