The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to frame policy regarding the duties of BLOs covering various aspects including leaves, transfer of station, compensation for the work done after school hours or on holidays, for which, legal notice dated 03.02.2020 (Annexure P-4) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners', the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 03.02.2020 (Annexure P-4) as

representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay as per law.
