The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to learned Revisional Court to decide the revision petition arising out of dismissal of the application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. in a case FIR No.117 dated 06.05.2002, registered under Sections 420, 467, 471, 342, 365, 448, 506 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana or in the alternative for staying the proceedings in the trial till the decision of the said application and also for setting aside the orders dated 30.07.2021 and 20.09.2021 passed by learned Revisional Court (Annexures P-15 and P-17 respectively) on the applications, one for the preponement dated 20.07.2021 and another for stay of the proceedings dated 02.09.2021 before learned Revisional Court (Annexures P-14 and P-16 respectively). The matter is now fixed before Revisional Court for 06.12.2021.

The limited prayer is that a direction be issued to the learned Revisional Court to decide the revision petition in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion .

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He does not intend to file any reply and therefore, has no objection if an appropriate direction be given to the Revisional Court.

In considered opinion of this Court, the ends of justice will be fully met if the learned Revisional Court is directed to decide the revision petition preferably within one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Every endeavour shall be made by the Revisional Court to pass the appropriate order on the revision petition within the time granted by this Court.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid direction.
