The present petition has been filed for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondent authorities to immediately rescue 36 detenues/bonded labourers from their bondage.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions received from SDM, Bhagha Purana submits that competent officers had visited the spot and recorded the statement including those of the petitioners.

A perusal of the enquiry reveals that there were no bonded labours and the allegations in the petition are found to be false and incorrect.

Given above, the instant petition is dismissed.
