[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Learned counsel contends that Physical Screening Test for the post of Sub-Inspector was scheduled for 23.10.2021 at 6.00 a.m. but since the petitioner was suffering from high fever, therefore, he could not complete the race within the stipulated period of time.

[3] Learned counsel contends that on 23.10.2021 itself, notice, Annexure P/6 was issued by the respondents that candidates who could not participate in the Physical Screening Test would be given another chance and that in the circumstances, the petitioner submitted representation, Annexure P/8 dated 25.10.2021 along with prescription slip, Annexure P/5 dated 22.10.2021 showing him suffering from high fever, and praying for grant of fresh opportunity but no decision has been taken on the claim made in the representation, Annexure P/8. Learned Counsel states that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is

disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide

representation, Annexure P/8 dated 25.10.2021 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[4] Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

[5] Ms. Upasana Dhawan, learned AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and after perusal of the writ petition states that she has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

[6] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P/8 dated 25.10.2021 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible, preferably within one week of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[7] Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
