This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the official respondent No.2 to follow the guidelines issued by Director General of Police, in which official respondent No.3 is conducting inquiry without any authority, which is against the guidelines issued by Director General of Police, Punjab dated 01.04.2008 (Annexure P-7) on the complaint of respondent No.4. Further prayer is for directing respondent No.3 not to initiate inquiry on the complaint of respondent No.4.

Admittedly, pursuant to the complaint (Annexure P-6) given by respondent No.4-Sham Kapoor before police, no FIR has been registered so far.

Resultantly, mere submission of the complaint before police cannot be treated as a valid cause of action to entertain the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
