The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.0291, dated 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2021, registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Model Town Rewari, District Rewari.

2. The Petitioner has remained in detention for nearly two months since 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

3. After completion of investigation, Challan against him has already been submitted, and the Charges were framed on 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 but the Prosecution evidence is yet to start.

4. Co-accused Yashpal, who was arrested on the same date as the present Petitioner, has already been granted bail by the Ld. Addl.

Sessions Judge, Rewari.

5. In the circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner, at this stage, for an indefinite period is not called for. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
