The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.102, dated 15.12.2019, under Sections 376-D, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (Sections 450 and 120-B of the IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Shahpur Kandi, District Pathankot, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has failed to satisfy this Court *qua* the maintainability of the instant petition as the earlier petition filed for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed as withdrawn on 27.01.2020. Even otherwise, a perusal of the contents of the FIR in question reveals that there are specific and serious attributions *qua* the petitioners in the crime in question which in the opinion of this Court does not entitle them to the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the aforesaid, instant petition is hereby dismissed.
