KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

Through the present petition, a limited prayer has been made by the petitioner that he be permitted to released on common surety in all the 14 FIRs and one criminal complaint, the details of which are given in Annexure P-1.

As per the petitioner, he has been granted regular bail in all the aforesaid criminal cases whose details is given in Annexure P-1. This fact has not been refuted by learned State counsel.

It is not possible for the petitioner to furnish separate surety in the aforesaid criminal cases. Further more, if one surety is ready to furnish common surety, then there should be no objection in accepting such surety bonds.

This Court is inclined to accept the aforesaid prayer of the petitioner in light of order dated 29.10.2018 passed by Hon'ble Supreme

Uttar Pradesh in SLP (Criminal) Nos.8914-15 of 2018 wherein it was held that personal bond so executed by the accused and bond so executed by two sureties shall hold good for all 31 criminal cases in which the accused was involved.

In view of above, the petitioner is allowed to furnish common surety in all the cases mentioned in Annexure P-1. In 3 cases in which he is granted bail subject to furnishing of two sureties, he is directed to furnish second common surety. However, while accepting the bail bonds, the Court concerned is to verify that said common sureties are sound and genuine and are satisfying all conditions of bail orders relating to every case. However, the petitioner shall furnish separate personal bonds in all the aforesaid cases.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
