Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action in FIR No.152 dated 29.04.2021 under Section 304-A and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Section Patran, District Patiala, Punjab.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that due to rash and negligent driving of a Trola, it met an accident with a car in which Ashish and Naveen were travelling. Both of them died as a result of the accident. He further submits that even though information was immediately given to the Police, neither offence under Section 279, IPC has been added nor the driver has been arrested as the owner of the offending vehicle is related to a high ranking police official. Rather, petitioner is being pressurized to

compromise the matter. He submits that petitioner has submitted representations to the respondents No.2 and 3, which are pending, and the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the authorities to look into the same.

Request of counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 17.09.2021, Annexure P-4, and to take suitable action as warranted thereon in accordance with law.

A copy of the order along with the representation, Annexure P-4, be sent to respondent No.3 in order to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
